HOUSE PRO-FAMILY ISSUES

1. Balance of Powers

Introduced by Representative Henry Mock (*District 4, Carroll*) CACR5 is a Concurrent Resolution for a Constitutional Amendment to repeal Article 73-A. CACR5 provides the rule making authority to remain with the Supreme Court but reestablishes the oversight authority of the legislature.

Passed 1/15/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

2. Divorce Reform

Introduced by Representative Gary Hopper (*District 48, Hillsborough*) HB351 requires married parents of minor children to complete a child impact seminar 6 months prior to filing a divorce petition.

Failed 1/7/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

3. Public Funded Abortions

Introduced by Representative Tim Eason (*District 68, Strafford*) HB1253, prohibits the use of public funds, employees, and facilities to assist or to perform abortions.

Failed 2/19/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

4. Abortion Statistics

Introduced by Representative Fran Wendleboe (*District 29, Belknap*) HB 1177 requires that NH Department of Health & Human Services to compile and maintain induced termination of pregnancy statistics.

Failed 3/11/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

5. Unborn Victims of Violence Act

Introduced by Representative Kathleen Souza (*District 51, Hillsborough*) HB1360, includes the "unborn child" in the definition of "another" for the purpose of capital murder, first and second degree murder, manslaughter, and negligent homicide. The recorded vote was to send the bill to interim study.

Failed 3/18/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

6. Taxpayer Bill of Rights

Introduced by Rep. Elbert Bicknell (*District 73, Rockingham*) CACR22 is a Concurrent Resolution for a Constitutional Amendment to require a 2/3 vote to pass a new tax or to increase a tax after it is levied and to limit the maximum increase in any budget bill to the rates of inflation and population growth.

Failed 3/18/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

7. Educational Choice

Introduced by Representative Ken Weyler (*District 79, Rockingham*) HB754 establishes an education certificate program to allow parental choice in selecting a school for their children's education for grades K through 12. The bill is in interim study.

Passed 1/15/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

8. Definition of Marriage

Introduced by Senator Russell Prescott (*District 23, Sullivan*) SB427 applies the definition of marriage in New Hampshire to all, residents and non-residents.

Passed 4/29/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

9. Dispensing Emergency Contraception

Introduced by Senator Lou D'Allesandro (*District 20, Sullivan*) SB484 establishes the ability of a pharmacist to initiate emergency contraceptive drug therapy to any age woman.

Passed 5/5/2004 – CPR opposed this Bill

10. Right to Carry

Introduced by Senator Russell Prescott (*District 23, Sullivan*) SB 454 re-establishes the second amendment right to bear arms without restriction.

Failed 4/29/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

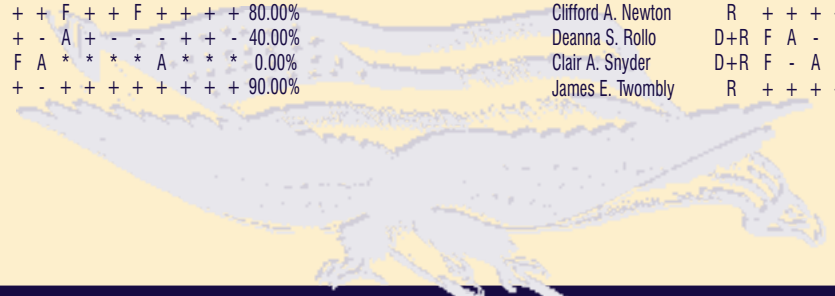

SENATE PRO-FAMILY ISSUES

1. Definition of Marriage

Introduced by Senator Russell Prescott (*District 23, Sullivan*) SB427 applies the definition of marriage in New Hampshire to all, residents and non-residents.

Passed 3/11/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

2. Dispensing Emergency Contraception

Introduced by Senator Lou D'Allesandro (*District 20, Sullivan*) SB484 establishes the ability of a pharmacist to initiate emergency contraceptive drug therapy to any age woman.

Governor's Veto Sustained 6/17/2004 – CPR Supported the Veto

3. Right to Carry

Introduced by Senator Russell Prescott (*District 23, Sullivan*) SB454 re-establishes the second amendment right to bear arms without restriction.

Passed 2/19/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

4. Right to Work

Introduced by Senator Russell Prescott (*District 23, Sullivan*) SB528 establishes the freedom of choice to join a labor union. The vote sends the bill to interim study.

Passed 3/17/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

5. Video Lottery

Introduced by Senator Lou D'Allesandro (*District 20, Sullivan*) SB117 authorizes a video lottery. The vote sends the bill to interim study.

Passed 1/22/2004 – CPR opposes the Bill; supports sending it to Interim Study

6. Parental Support during Legal Proceedings

Introduced by Representative Gary Hopper (*District 48, Hillsborough*) HB1367 allows parents or legal guardians to remain with a sexual assault victim who is a minor during legal proceedings.

Passed 4/29/2004 – CPR supported this Bill

7. Balance of Powers

Introduced by Representative Henry Mock (*District 4, Carroll*) CACR5 is a Concurrent Resolution for a Constitutional Amendment to repeal Article 73-A. CACR5 provides the rule making authority to remain with the Supreme Court but reestablishes the oversight authority of the legislature.

Passed 4/29/2004 – CPR supported this Bill
