About This Voter Guide

Cornerstone’s 2012 Families First Voter Guide presents information that should help you choose the best pro-family candidates in your district. This guide compiles, to the greatest extent possible, the voting record of incumbent candidates, or for those candidates who are non-incumbents, their public statements. For state House and Senate races, the guide lists scores from the [2011-12 Cornerstone Scorecard](#), and for all races, the guide makes note of whether each candidate has signed and returned Cornerstone’s [Families First Pledge](#), a sample of which is included on the last page of this guide.

Each candidate running for legislative or executive offices was given the opportunity to sign the Families First Pledge, regardless of party or whether running for the first time or running for reelection.

How to Use This Voter Guide for State Offices

1. Use the “Find Your House District” and “Find Your Senate District” pages to look up your state House and Senate districts. (Note: Some communities will have more than one House district. To learn why that is, consult the “Note About New Hampshire House Districts” section to the right.)
2. Once you have found your districts, turn to the House Voter Guide and the Senate Voter Guide and look up the candidates running in your districts. The House Voter Guide makes note of the number of seats in each district. You will have the opportunity to vote for as many candidates as there are seats available.

Note About New Hampshire State House Districts

You will notice that some communities or city wards have multiple House districts associated with them. This is not a mistake. Because of redistricting and the Legislature’s effort to balance the requirements of the state and federal constitutions, some communities will have representatives devoted completely to their community. Other communities will have representatives devoted solely to their community as well as representatives for their community and neighboring communities (these are called “floatorial” districts). Those communities that didn’t qualify for their own district will only have representatives that they share with neighboring communities.
