



## 2014 Families First Voter Guide

### **About the 2014 guide to the New Hampshire primary election:**

Cornerstone Action provides this information to help you select the candidates most supportive of family-friendly policies including the right to life, strong marriages, and choice in education, sound fiscal management, and keeping New Hampshire casino-free.

### **What's in the guide and how we calculated the ratings :**

Cornerstone invited all candidates to sign the Families First Pledge. We have indicated on this guide who has signed the pledge without candidate having modified it in any way.

Voting records are drawn from the 2014 legislative session, for incumbent state legislators running for re-election. We include results from three Senate votes and eight House votes.

A candidate's percentage mark is for votes cast in 2014. There is no penalty for an excused absence from a vote; however, an unexcused absence or "not voting" is penalized by being included as a "no" vote. Excessive absences yield a no score.
